

# Be a Warrior for a Day

Brother Rice encourages any eighth grade student to visit and become a “Warrior” for the day. Students and families will have the opportunity to receive a school tour, visit with Brother Rice students & faculty, and engage in classroom activities with a student host.

**7:45 am** Arrive at the front of the school, come through the front glass doors and immediately to the left is our main office, this is where you check in.

**7:55 am** 8th grade students and parents (parents optional) receive a school tour from David Sofran or Brian Kalczynski (Admission Officers). This is a great opportunity to ask specific questions about Brother Rice.

**8:41 am** 8th grade student is paired with a current student he knows at Brother Rice or with a 9th grader that has similar interests.

**8:41 am - 2 pm** Attend classes with your host. This is a great opportunity to see our teachers in action and students’ interaction with each other.

**2 - 2:15 pm** One-on-one interview with an Admissions Officer. This is one of the five criteria requirements for admission into Brother Rice.

**2:15 - 2:30 pm** Parents may pick up their son, and any additional questions can be answered at that time by either Admissions Officer.

- Please turn in completed application during your visit day.
- Lunch is provided by Brother Rice, so 8th graders do not have to bring a lunch.
- 8th grade students should bring a book or homework in case the Brother Rice host has a test in a particular class that day.
- 8th grade students should wear dress shoes, dress slacks or khaki pants, dress shirt and tie
